Creative Movement/Intro to Ballet

A wonderful class for both boys and girls in which their kinesthetic intelligence will expand by leaps and bounds! A fun and active class where children explore movement, music, rhythm, and dance. Emphasis is placed on developing coordination, muscle strength, flexibility, balance, and body control. Students will be introduced to games, rhythm exercises, and basic Ballet vocabulary and skills.

Ballet 1/2

Class levels are designed so that students can progress through the ballet curriculum safely with age-appropriate challenges. Class includes a traditional warm-up at the barre, followed by a center progression through adagio, petite allegro, and grande allegro exercises. Emphasis is placed on working safely within the ballet knowledge and application of proper vocabulary and terminology, efficient and correct placement and body alignment, musicality, and artistic expression.

Registration, Recital, and Tuition Fee Information

The annual registration fee (per student) is \$35 and is collected at the time you enroll. Recital participation is a one-time fee of \$40, collected on March 1st. For students taking more than 1 performance class, there is a \$20 fee per additional class, (so if students are enrolled in both classes recital fees will equal \$60.
