In each workshop, students will have the opportunity to learn a brief routine, culminating in a performance at Moscow Farmers Market on Saturday, July 20<sup>th</sup> from 9:30am-10:30am. Classes begin Monday, July 15, 2019, and are held in the multi-purpose room at Genesee School.

## Judy Drown

Judy “JD” Drown is a Moscow, Idaho, native who began dancing at Festival Dance and Performing Arts Academy when she was young. She was first captivated by Celtic dance, and as she grew, she expanded her dance knowledge to Tap, Jazz, Hip Hop, and Ballet. Her passion for artistic movement deepened as she graduated with her Bachelor of Science in Dance from the University of Idaho Dance Program, where she was exposed to Modern, African, and Belly dance genres. Since graduating, JD has studied with Movement Theater Studio, Idaho School of Massage Therapy, and Body Arts and Science International (BASI) Pilates to further investigate her curiosity about human movement potential.

Drown currently performs, collaborates, and trains with the University of Idaho’s World Beat Ensemble, Mystic Rhythms Tribal Belly Dance Troupe, and various local groups seeking to incorporate dance in their programming. She currently serves as Adjunct Faculty for the University of Idaho Dance Program (Hip Hop, Modern, and Tap), as lead faculty for Festival’s Discover Dance Outreach Programming (African, Jazz, Hip Hop, House, and Breaking), and as faculty for Festival Dance Academy (Jazz, Hip Hop, Lyrical, Contemporary, Pilates, and Yoga).

Her pedagogical approach to dance training prioritizes instructing through healthy practice while utilizing her diverse knowledge base to help bring movement and self-expression to her students as they grown their personal passion for dance.
