



PARKING at UI and MMSPT

Festival Dance UNIVERSITY OF IDAHO Campus

All Moscow classes at the University of Idaho campus are held in Studio Lab 212, on the second floor of the Physical Education Building (PEB) on the University of Idaho Campus. The Festival Dance main office is located in room 120, on the first floor. The Physical Education Building is located directly east of the Kibbie Dome, across Rayburn Street, and we share a parking lot with Memorial Gym and the UI Swim Center. Parking can be difficult on campus, as this parking lot requires a UI Gold Parking Pass until 5:00pm, Monday - Friday. There are four metered spots in the parking lot, temporary 10-minute parking spots, and there are several pay-to-park spots on Rayburn (you'll find payment kiosks located along the street).

Due to parking circumstances, we have established a system of parking lot drop-off/return for young students whose classes are held during peak parking lot times so that parents do not have to locate parking or worry about students getting into the building. A Festival Dance faculty or staff member will be waiting in the parking lot (see PEB Parking Lot and Location Map) by the west wall of the swim center wearing a **bright, rainbow colored lei** for 10 minutes before the start of class. At 5 minutes before the start of class, they will walk all dropped off students up to the studio lab together. Any students who arrive during that time will be able to wait with the instructor and walk as a group into the building and up to the studio to begin class. Students who arrive within 5 minutes of class start time will need to enter the building and navigate to the studio independently or with a parent/guardian, as waiting any longer delays the start of class for students who arrived on time. For example, if a class begins at 3:30pm, the instructor will be in the parking lot by the west wall of the swim center from 3:20-3:25pm. At 3:25pm the instructor will walk the students into the building and up to the studio. Students who arrive after 3:25pm will need to enter the building and studio on their own. At the conclusion of class, students will be walked back out to the parking lot for pick up. Please be courteous by being

present to pick up your young dancer early or on time.

Moscow Mountain Sport & Physical Therapy has a beautiful facility that we are privileged to have the opportunity to utilize for our classes. This space offers incredible natural light, an adjustable barre to accommodate young dancers of varied heights, gorgeous floors with gentle cushioning to protect feet and joints, restrooms, water fountains, and a waiting area available to parents just around the corner from the room in which students take class.

Parking at Moscow Mountain Sport & Physical Therapy is free during our dance class times. Please utilize any available parking space upon arrival, but please *do not* double park. Dancers and parents can enter the building through the ramp on the side of the building. Please do not the front entrance to the business. Please enter the door to the right at the top of the ramp--marked "Speed Center". Dance class is held just inside this door on the right side of the room where you will see a ballet barre. Just inside the door to the left, there are restrooms, water fountains, and couches for parents to wait while your dancer enjoys class. The restroom may also be utilized as a changing room if students need to put dance clothes on upon arrival. Please exercise caution when walking up the ramp during winter months, as there may be ice.
